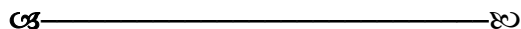


***The Library is open ***

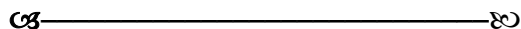
There are always Beth Sholomites visiting Israel. Please let us know when you are going to and returning from Israel.

Please turn off your pager or cell phone while at Beth Sholom on Shabbat. If you must be available for emergency calls, please set it to “vibrate.”

In case of a medical emergency, there is a medical bag and an oxygen tank located in the closet near the entrance of the auditorium. There are defibrillators mounted on the wall adjacent to the elevator in the lobby outside the Auditorium and in the main foyer. First aid kits are located in the main kitchen off the Auditorium, in the Curtis Hereld Room kitchen, and in the synagogue office.

Please familiarize yourself with the location of emergency exits. Should there be an emergency or the alarms go off, please exit the building immediately. Your children will be led out by their group leaders. You can meet them across the street at the corner of Rugby Road and Rutland Avenue.

Do you want to know what a word or phrase in the *siddur* means? For a more literal translation, there are two *siddurim* with intralinear translations on the counters at the side of the room. These *siddurim* should be returned to their places after you have consulted them.
