EMERGENCY EXITS AND MEDICAL EMERGENCY

In case of a medical emergency, there is a medical bag and an oxygen tank located in the closet near the entrance of the auditorium. There are defibrillators mounted on the wall adjacent to the elevator in the lobby outside the Auditorium and in the main foyer.
